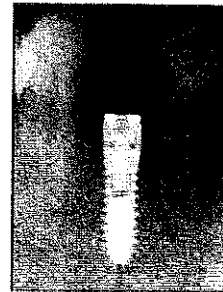

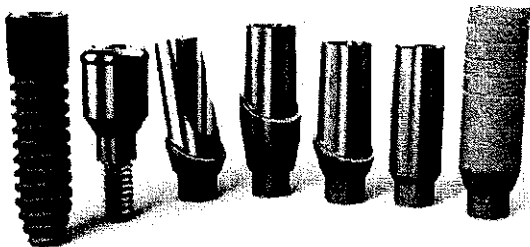
Radiograph shows proper implant spacing in limited site.

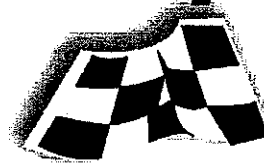
