Executive Board Meeting Minutes

The Volusia-Flagler Dental Association Executive Committee convened at 5:47 pm.

Points of Discussion

- I. **Approval of meeting minutes from October meeting** - The minutes were dispersed and reviewed. Dr. Borer motioned to approve the minutes, and it was seconded by Dr. MacIntyre. The motion carried.
- II. **Treasurer's Report** – Dr. MacIntyre dispersed the financial report.
 - A. Collection of meal fees from Life members continue to be difficult. Life members are required to pay \$35 per meeting to cover the meal and space rental fees. Many life members continue not to pay. According to the by-laws for Life membership, Life members must be at least 65 years of age, and must have been members for 35 continuous years in the VFCDA.
 - B. Dr. MacIntyre will collect the \$5,000 PNC Bank sponsorship as well as the ADS sponsorship.
- III. Old Business:
 - A. **Speakers**– Dr. Patel reported that he is still seeking a speaker for the January meeting.
 - B. **Joint All Day February Meeting**- In lieu of a February meeting, the VFCDA will join the Brevard County Dental Association for an all-day meeting on February 19, 2016. Our October speaker, Dr. Hyung-Jun Kong will address Brevard County at their monthly meeting on February 18, 2016. All interested VFCDA members are both invited and encouraged to attend.
 - C. **Installation Banquet**- Dr. Borer reserved the Oceanside Country Club for the Installation Banquet on May 6, 2016.
- III. New Business:
 - A. Location for Next Year's Meetings: Dr. Patel has spoken to several facilities regarding hosting our next year's meetings. Both Hyde Park and LPGA do not charge a room fee. However, cost of food per person appears to be the same as what the Speedway charges. Dr. Patel will gather more precise information to aid our decision regarding next year's venue.
 - B. Next Year's Budget– Dr. Patel and Dr. MacIntyre will work together to establish next year's budget.
 - C. RSVPs: The RSVPs remain problematic. Dr. Kometas will send two RSVP emails next month. Dr. Larkin, Dr. Patel, and Dr. MacIntyre must be congratulated for constructing a phone tree. Combining e-mails with phone calls has increased meeting attendance. However, to ensure that enough meals are ordered for everyone, and to prevent surplus meal orders, our members must RSVP!
 - D. Marisa Kometas has been officially declared the editor for the association,. She is in charge of the monthly newsletter.
